Analysis

- 68% of children have achieved at least the expected standard in maths
- 68% of children have achieved at least the expected standard in reading and 63% of children in writing
- In this cohort of children there are many children with significant needs. 2 children have autism, 2 have English as a second language and 5 have learning difficulties as well as emotional/social needs.

Analysis

- 69% of children have achieved at least the expected standard in maths
- 64% of children have achieved at least the expected standard in reading and writing
- 77% of children have achieved at least the expected standard in writing

- In this cohort of children there are many children with significant needs. 2 children have autism and 6 have learning difficulties as well as emotional/social needs.

Analysis

- 77% of children have achieved at least the expected standard in maths
- 77% of children have achieved at least the expected standard in reading and writing
- 77% of children have achieved at least the expected standard in writing
- For reading and writing the GDS has increased significantly from last year
- Of the 3 children working at Pre-Key Stage, 2 are Syrian Refugees who had no English language and have only been in the country for a year and the other has severe needs.
